

School Admission Policy 2019/2020

Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Primary School

Wednesday 20th December 2017

To whom it may concern,

Under the School Admissions Code (2014) when changes are proposed to admission arrangements, all admission authorities must consult on their admission arrangements (including any supplementary information form) that will apply for admission applications the following school year.

Admission authorities must consult with: a) parents of children between the ages of two and eighteen; b) other persons in the relevant area who in the opinion of the admission authority have an interest in the proposed admissions; c) all other admission authorities within the relevant area (except that primary schools need not consult secondary schools); d) whichever of the governing body and the local authority who are not the admission authority; e) any adjoining neighbouring local authorities where the admission authority is the local authority; and f) in the case of schools designated with a religious character, the body or person representing the religion or religious denomination.

A copy of the proposed admission arrangements can be found on the school website under 'admissions'. Admission authorities must also send upon request a copy of the proposed admission arrangements to any of the persons or bodies listed above inviting comment. Comments in writing should be addressed to the school or by email to office@olmcprimary.co.uk.

The deadline for comments is 31st January 2018.
