Holidays within Term time

Every school day counts towards your child's future. Days off school add up to lost learning.

In total there are 175 non-school days a year. This gives families the opportunity to:

spend time together, go on family visits, holidays, go on days out or attend routine appointments

The law says that parents do not have the right to take their child out of school for holidays during term time except in exceptional circumstances. The two exceptional circumstances are:

Where it is company/organisational policy for an employee to take leave at a specific time in the year and there is no opportunity for family holiday in school Holidays. This must be evidenced by production of the policy document of the organisation.

Service personnel returning from/scheduled to embark upon a tour of duty abroad.

If you take your child on holiday during term time without the school's authorisation this will be recorded as unauthorised absence and may result in parents being issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice. All requests should be made on an 'Application for Leave of Absence for Annual Holiday' form which is available from the school office. You should also submit any evidence to support your exceptional circumstances. This should be submitted no later than 21 days before the start of the holiday.

Y2, Y3, Y4 and Y6 – Wednesday 28th March 2.30pm through to 7:30pm. This provides an opportunity to visit classrooms to see your child's work and to talk to the teacher.
